Crédit Agricole CIB to opt-in as Systematic Internaliser as of 3 January, 2018

London – 6 December, 2017. Crédit Agricole Corporate and Investment Bank (“Crédit Agricole CIB”) announces that it registers to operate as Systematic Internaliser (“SI”) for all Fixed Income, Forex and derivatives products. Introduced by the Market in Financial Market Directive reform (MiFID II), Systematic Internalisers are providing equivalent level of transparency to their clients as a regulated market, notably by publishing pre trade quotes and disclosing transaction details post trade.

“Given our leading position in European Fixed Income and Forex markets, we took the decision to opt-in well ahead of the September 2018 deadline, as imposed by the MiFID II regulation, to best support our clients, committing to provide liquidity and alleviating reporting duties such as Post Trade Transparency.” explains Isabelle Girolami, Head of Global Markets at Crédit Agricole CIB.
